On Sunday, April 17, 2022, we kicked off our capital campaign, Upholding Our Values, with a goal of raising \$1.3 million over

the next 3 years. This campaign will allow us to

- make significant progress on our Vision 20/50 Climate Action goals,
- retire our mortgage, and
- save over \$100,000 annually in operating expenses that we can redeploy to other Vision 20/50 goals.
